Proposals should include the development and application of tools in support of integrated air quality and climate change governance in EU Member States, with the aim of designing and implementing adequate abatement strategies and practices. The specific circumstances of the different regions and cities of

areas. Furthermore, awareness-raising actions and policy support activities should be included. Proposals should include the participation of SMEs, as far as possible.

The Commission considers that proposals requesting a contribution from the EU of between EUR 6 and 8 million would allow this specific challenge to be addressed appropriately. Nonetheless, this does not preclude submission and selection of proposals requesting other amounts.

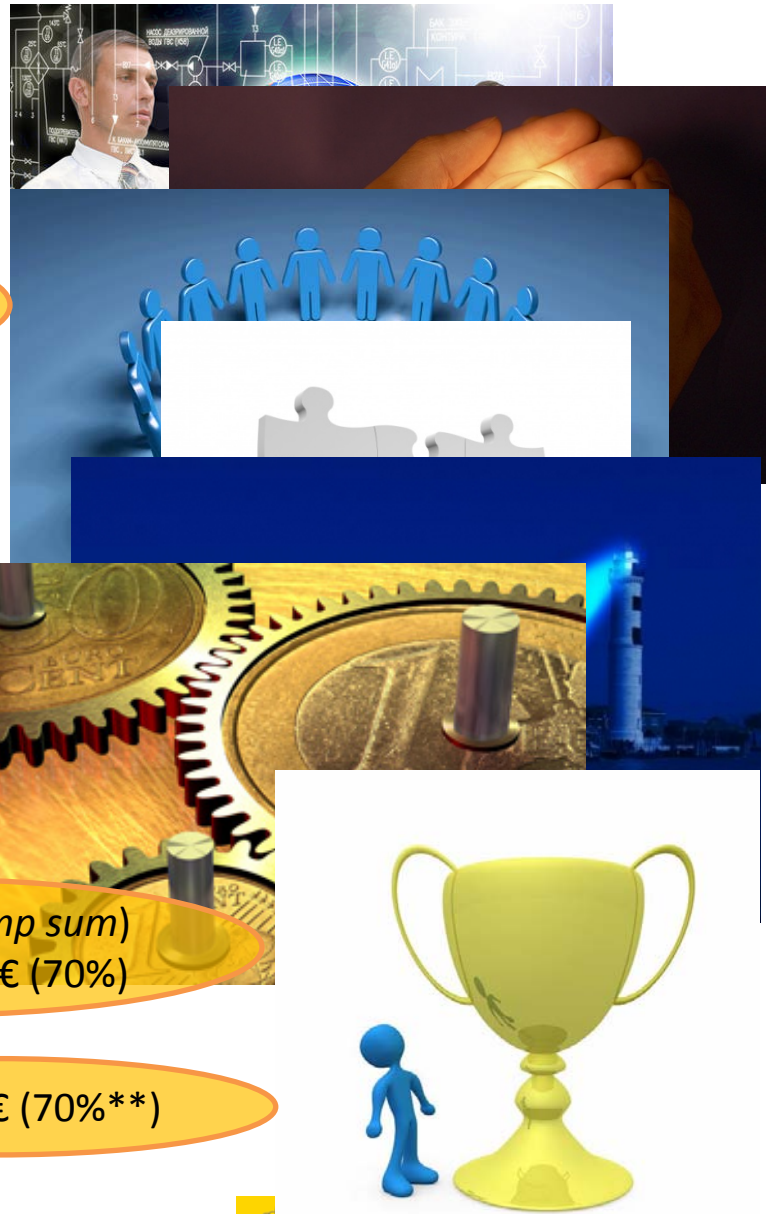

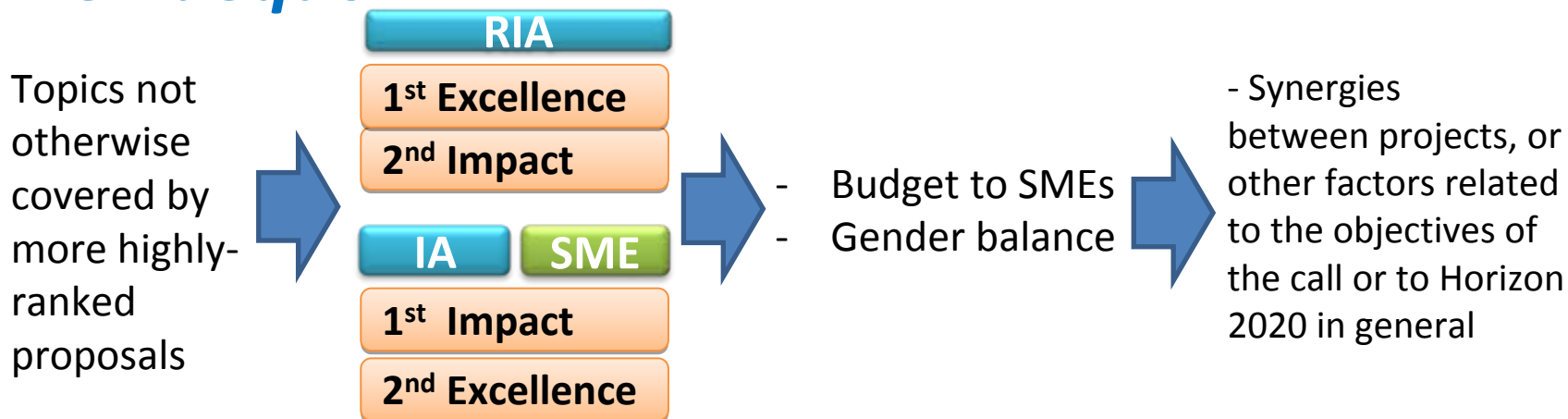

# RRI – Responsible Research Innovation

## European Commission

RRI is now a **legal text of H2020** from the European Parliament, (Preamble 22):

*“(22) With the aim of **deepening the relationship between science and society** and reinforcing public confidence in science, Horizon 2020 should (...) by developing responsible research and innovation agendas that **meet citizens’ and civil society’s concerns and expectations...**”*
